

The Department of Mathematics at the University of Nebraska – Omaha (UNO) invites applications for a full-time tenure-track assistant-professor position beginning August 2019. Applicants must have a Ph.D. (or be ABD) in operations research or a closely related field.

Operations research, along with statistics and data science, compose the rapidly-growing Data Sciences program within the UNO Mathematics Department. Faculty enjoy interdisciplinary collaborations with colleagues across UNO and the University of Nebraska system. Mathematics students can choose a concentration in any of these three areas at both the undergraduate and master's levels. The successful candidate will work closely with faculty and students in the Data Sciences group, teach undergraduate and graduate courses in operations research, supervise graduate students, collaborate with local industry, and maintain an active research program.

The university and department have a strong commitment to achieving diversity among faculty and staff. We are particularly interested in receiving applications from members of under-represented groups and strongly encourage women and persons of color to apply for this position.
