

How to save a Stata graph when using a Mac

1. Create a graph with a command like “graph box myvariable” (or whatever).
2. Save the graph by either right-clicking on the graph and choosing “Save” or by clicking on the disk icon that is in the bar along the top of the window with the graph.
3. When saving, we recommend choosing to save the file as .tif format. You can choose this by using the “Format” dropdown menu.
4. Also when saving, name the file (and remember where you save it to!).
5. Import the image into whatever program you are using to write up your work. For Microsoft Word, choose Insert > Picture > From File ... from the menus at the top of the screen and navigate to the saved image file.
