

Lecturer

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Northern Arizona University invites applications for a non-tenure-track lecturer position beginning August 2021. Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate statistics and/or mathematics courses, typically at the lower-division level.

Candidates must have a master's degree in statistics or mathematics before the beginning contract date and at least one semester of college-level teaching experience as the teacher of record. Preference will be given to candidates with

- Completed doctorate in statistics or mathematics at the time of application
- A record of substantial and continued effectiveness in teaching, especially in college-level statistics or mathematics courses
- Ability to teach a wide variety of courses
- Experience and/or commitment to work effectively with NAU's diverse faculty, staff, and student populations

Salary: \$48,500 per academic year

Northern Arizona University is an approximately 30,000-student institution with its main campus in Flagstaff, a four-season community of about 70,000 at the base of the majestic San Francisco Peaks. NAU's emphasis on undergraduate education is enhanced by its graduate programs and research as well as distance learning. All faculty members are expected to promote student learning and help students achieve academic outcomes. The university is committed to a diverse and civil working and learning environment.

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics has 37 permanent faculty and offers bachelor's degrees in mathematics and secondary (grades 6-12) mathematics education; master's degrees in mathematics, mathematics education, and statistics; and graduate certificates in applied statistics and teaching introductory community college mathematics.

This position will be open until filled or closed. Review of applications will begin on June 1, 2021.
