This is a very unique position which rarely comes up at our institution. It is a hard salaried faculty position with the federal government - as such, U.S. citizenship is required for this position. I would also like to mention that this is a very exciting moment to be working at a place with great access to the various enormous military medical datasets which have barely been tapped into to date.
